5. Encourage your child to read books, magazines, newspapers, and journals.
6. Meet with your child's teachers before problems arise.
7. Inform your child's school and teachers of changes in the home that may affect your child's ability to stay focused or attend school.
8. Assist your child in securing the materials needed to complete projects and assignments.
9. Talk to your child, and encourage him/her to do well in school.
10. MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD ARRIVES AT SCHOOL EVERYDAY ON TIME AND PREPARED TO LEARN.

**Creating and Sustaining a Safe Learning Environment**

\*Discuss the school's disciplinary code with your child.

\*Prevent problems by having your child follow school and classroom policies.

\*Meet your child's teachers within the first 2-3 weeks of school.

\*Give correct contact information to the school and to the teachers.

Visit the school to observe your child.

\*Volunteer one hour per month in your child's school.

\*Recruit family members to help with your child's schooling.

Document! Document! Document!

\*Document every time you call the school, with whom you spoke, the reason for the call, and the results.

\*Immediately conference with the teacher and/or principal to resolve any concerns about teacher competency or the classroom environment.

**DO NOT TEACH YOUR CHILD BAD HABITS AND EXPECT YOUR CHILD TO BE AN ANGEL IN SCHOOL AND IN THE CLASSROOM. REMEMBER, YOUR CHILD WILL MIMIC YOUR BEHAVIOR; YOUR CHILD WILL EXPOSE YOUR CONDUCT.**
